Anthony Livanios is the CEO of **Energy Stream CMG**, an international advisory firm whose goal is to provide top quality analysis and expert opinion to the oil and gas industry. The company develops and implements growth strategies to provide market intelligence in the Gulf, Mediterranean and Caspian regions. He has over 20 years of experience on business to government relations, energy issues, international affairs, and research. He has implemented a number of projects on business development and promotion of investments for government and public sector organizations as well as private businesses. His experience spans over 50 countries in the Arab world, Caspian region, Europe, and North America. He has developed a strong global network in the areas of energy and international relations.

He was President of **Poseidon S.A.**, Offshore Natural Gas Greek-Italian Pipeline in 2009-2010. He has successfully worked, achieving agreement on all matters he managed between the shareholders of Poseidon S.A., namely the Greek Public Gas Corporation **DEPA S.A.** (holding 50% of shares) and the Italian **Edison** (also holding 50% of shares) the largest private energy company in Italy. As President of Poseidon S.A., he negotiated the signing of the **agreement for the construction of the Greek-Bulgarian Natural Gas Pipeline (IGB) with Bulgarian Energy Holding**, the largest energy company in Bulgaria. He submitted and negotiated investment proposals to the European Union for securing a €145 million grant for the construction of the Greek-Italian and Greek-Bulgarian pipeline interconnectors.

In 2000 he founded **Alpha Metrics** a research and business development company, where he served as Chief Executive Officer. He specialized in business to government relations, public consultations, market and public opinion research. In 1994 he established a sole proprietorship company specializing in research and business development services. He introduced new techniques in the Greek market and, focusing on the validity of research projects, he participated in strategic decision-making for government organizations and private businesses he worked with.

Between 1987 and 1992 he did international work for the Wharton Econometrics Forecasting Associates in **Brussels, Belgium**, for Weiman Volkwirt - Journalisten in **Hamburg, Germany**, and the Greek Consulate in **New York**, on issues of international economic relations.

In 2001 he founded the **Hellenic Leadership Institute**, a Non-Governmental Organization with the aim to promote democracy, civil society and international economic development. He has implemented programs in the Middle East and the Balkans and has cooperated with various civil society organizations and many small-medium enterprises. He is a member of important international NGO networks in Europe and the USA. In 2006, he was honored with **two international Templeton Awards** for his active role and "outstanding work in the field of international development and cooperation in the region of South Eastern Mediterranean".

He often appears as a commentator and analyst on Greek and international political and economic issues on the most credible international media networks such as **CNN, Reuters, Associated Press, Al Jazeera**, and the **Middle East News Agency**, and newspapers such as **the Financial Times, New York Times, Wall Street Journal**, and **Al Ahram**.

(1991) with a specialization in international affairs, energy and security, and a **B.A. in Economics** from the **American University**, Washington, D.C.
